The Shikellamy School District is pleased to provide an Afterschool STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) Program for 3rd-8th graders that will benefit your child and help them meet their academic goals. This program is made possible through the 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant. All 3rd-8th grade students enrolled in the Shikellamy School District are eligible to participate at NO COST. Our school year program will begin on September 10th and run until May 30th, 2019.

AFTERSCHOOL STEAM PROGRAM

The Afterschool STEAM Program at Beck/Chief Elementary Schools operates Monday through Thursdays from 2:30 - 5:00 PM with a 5:00 - 5:30 PM time slot to allow any prescheduled parent meetings concerning the program. SMS/Oaklyn/Priestley Elementary Schools operate from 3:00 - 5:30 PM with a 5:30 - 6:00 PM parent slot. Parents/guardians may schedule meetings with staff and directors to discuss their child's participation in the program during the parent time slot. ALL BUSING STUDENTS will be picked up at 5:00 PM from SMS/Beck/Chief and 5:30 PM from Oaklyn/Priestley. In the program, your child will have the opportunity to work with teachers and outside educators on enrichment activities in the STEAM fields. In addition, students will participate in fun, engaging activities pertaining to health, arts, sports, home economics and more!

KIDS CAFE

The Kids Cafe is an opt in, NO COST Lunch Program provided to us through the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank. The meal often consists of an entrée, side, fruit or vegetable and milk. We serve the dinners prior to the end of our program. If you are interested, the Kids Cafe form is attached for you to fill out and return with your registration.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation home from the program is available to all students. If you prefer to provide your own transportation, your child must be picked up by 5:00 PM (Beck/Chief) or 5:30 PM (SMS/Oaklyn/Priestley) each day. Due to the limited number of buses available to the program, stops are restricted to those listed on the registration form. If you need assistance choosing a stop, please call our office. Students must provide a note for any change in transportation.

Please complete the attached forms and return them to your child's teacher or school building office. You will receive a phone call or email confirming you child's enrollment in the program from the Afterschool Staff.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCE: SNAP (FOOD STAMP) BENEFITS

SNAP, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, is the program formerly known as Food Stamps. It is a federal nutrition program that helps low-income individuals and families stretch their food budget and buy healthy food.

SNAP benefits can be used to purchase food at grocery stores, convenience stores and some farmers' markets and co-op food programs. Eligible households are provided SNAP benefits each month through an ACCESS card known as an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT), which works like a debit card.
